# Chislehurst Village Heritage Trail

1. **St Patrick's Church.** This is a church that used to be a cinema.

- If the church is open, look inside - can you find the cinema seats?
- Why did cheeky people call cinemas 'Bug Houses'?



2. **Burlington Parade** - Named after the man who built the shops.

- Name two of the shops in this row.
- The town of Burlington is in South Africa. How far is that from Chislehurst?

**3. The Manning and Anderdon Almshouses are a pretty row of houses built in 1881.**

- **Who would live in an Almshouse?**
- **How many houses are there here?**



**4. Church of the Annunciation.**

- **There is the name of a man carved into the Lych Gate. Find it and write it here.**
- **Draw something interesting that you see in the churchyard.**
- **Can you find a soldier's gravestone in the churchyard. What name is on it?**

## 5. Wellfield Place - Old Cottages on the High Street.

- Look for a date on a stone high up on these cottages. Write it here.
- Park Road is one way, why is it one way?
- Do you know the name of another one way road?



## 6. The Queen's Head is the oldest building on the High Street.

- Why would it have had stables in the 17th and 18th centuries?
- Can you guess what year this photograph was taken?

7. Prickend Pond – This is the name of the pond on the High Street.

- This was an old gravel pit; what was gravel used for?
- Name some of the birds you can see on the pond. Can you draw your favourite one?



8. Lash's Forge – Find the plaque on the wall of Barclays Bank. There was a blacksmith's forge here in 1792.

- Draw a horseshoe. Why are they usually drawn with the opening at the top?
- Give two uses for a horseshoe.

9. Cafe Rouge has the mark (monogram) of King George V above the door.

- What is the date on it?
- King George had a beard and a moustache; draw your idea of a King.



10. Annabel's II is on Stockman's Row

- Draw the owl high up above the shop. Which birds is it supposed to be scaring away?
- What is the date above Champion Wines next door?

11. **The Coffee Tavern sign is quite hard to spot, look up high.**

(you might look from the other side of the road - please cross the High Street at the lights)

- **There were once public baths in this building. Why don't we have them now?**
- **This was also a club with billiards and chess boards. If you ran a club what would you put in it?**



12. **The Old Metropolitan Police station building.**

- **Today it is not a police station. What is it now?**
- **Draw a picture of a policeman or policewoman in their uniform today.**
